**NOTIFICATION**

Dated Kohima the Feb'2016.

No.LAB-1/6/97 (Vol-I):: The Government of Nagaland is satisfied that for the rapid industrialization of State, it is necessary to exclude Boilers from certain provisions of the Boilers Act, 1923.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of section 34 of the Boilers Act, 1923 (No.5 of 1923), the Government of Nagaland hereby exclude Boilers which have been installed or which will be installed in future from the operation of the provision of section 7,8,9,10,12,13,14,15,16,17,19,20-A,21,22 and section 23 subject to the following conditions, namely:-

1. Before the use of boiler, the owner of the boiler may apply to the Chief Inspector of Factories & Boilers along with the following documents to have the Boilers registered:

- (a) As per the provision of clause (c) of sub-section (1) of section 14 of the Boilers Act, 1923, all necessary documents as provided in regulation 4 of the Indian Boilers Regulations 1950 along with application for registration of the Boiler.
- (b) A certificate from the "Boiler Engineer" with regard to the Boiler for the period and maximum pressure for which it can be safely used.

"Boiler Engineer" shall be a person:-

- (i) Who is a graduate in Mechanical or Production or Power Plant or Metallurgical Engineering from a recognized institution.
- (ii) Has a minimum five years experience singly or cumulatively in the following fields related to Boilers:-
  - Design
  - Manufacture
  - Commissioning
  - Operation and maintenance
  - Inspection and certification during manufacture or operation or maintenance
  - High Pressure Welding Inspection and
- (iii) Is registered with Chief Inspectors of Factories and Boilers as a "Boiler Engineer"
- (c) Fees as prescribed in (Rule 39 Nagaland Boiler Rules 1996).

2. Thereafter, an annual certificate from "Boiler Engineer", as given below shall be submitted to the Chief Inspector of Factories and Boilers with regard to the Boiler mentioning the pressure at which it can be safely used for a future period of 12 months.

**"Annual Certificate from Boiler Engineer"**

- (a) Registry number of Boiler/Economizer.
- (b) Name, Address, Telephone No, Mobile No, and e-mail address of boiler owner.
- (c) Address where Boiler/Economizer installed.
- (d) Name, Address, Telephone No, Mobile No, and e-mail address of "Boiler Engineer" reporting fitness of Boiler/ Economizer.
- (e) Certificate of "Boiler Engineer".

I have inspected the above boiler/economizer on \_\_\_\_\_ at the request of the boiler owner as required under Notification No. \_\_\_\_\_ dated \_\_\_\_\_ of Government of Nagaland and I hereby certify that the boiler/economizer is fit to operate for use at a pressure of \_\_\_\_\_ For a further period of 12 months i.e. from \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_.

3. It will be responsibility of the owner of the Boiler to run and maintain it as per provisions of the Boilers Act, 1923 and regulations and rules framed under the Act and owner shall also be responsible for any violation of the provisions or accident.
4. The "Boiler Engineer" shall follow the provision of the Boilers Act, 1923, rules & Regulations framed thereunder and shall be liable and responsible for any act or omission or commission committed against the provision of said Act, rules & regulations, including de-registration as "Boiler Engineer".
5. If the owner of boiler violates any provision of the Boilers Act, 1923, regulations and rules framed thereunder or any of the provisions, in additions to penal provisions in Boilers Act, 1923, a penalty of ₹.5000/- (Rupees Five thousand) only shall be imposed on him. For any subsequent offence, besides penalty of ₹ 500/- (Rupees five hundred) only per day shall be additionally imposed and /or restriction can be imposed on the use of the boiler. The Inspector of Factories and Boilers shall be the competent to impose the penalty or stop the use of the boiler. The owner may file an appeal with the Chief Inspector of Factories & Boilers within 30 (Thirty) days of the order passed by the Inspector of Factories & Boilers whose orders shall be final.
